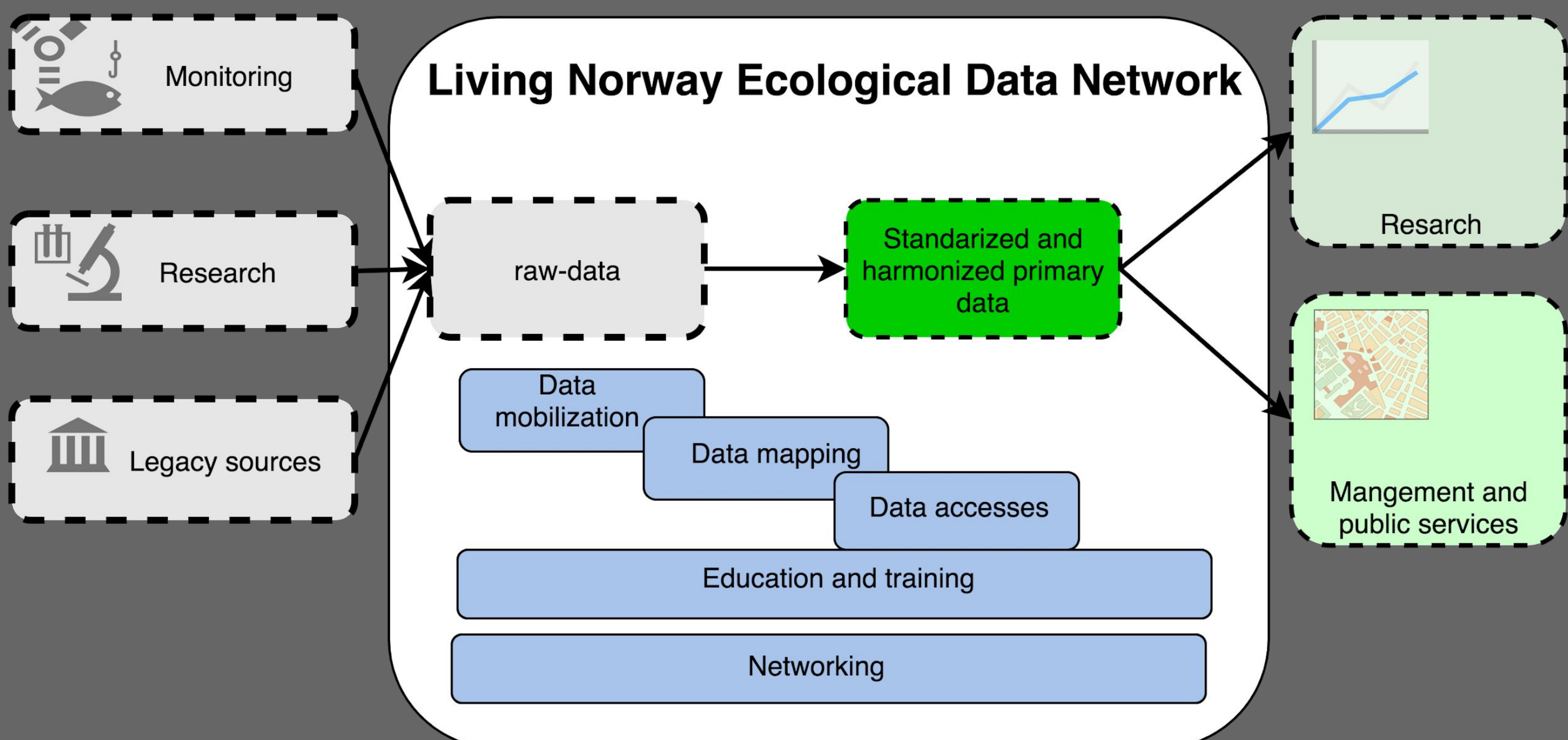
Ecological Data Network

- Promoting FAIR data management -

Living Norway Ecological Data Network is established to promote accessibility, discoverability, interoperability and re-use of ecological data from Norwegian research institutions. Once fully operational, Living Norway will contribute to and be part of the Living Atlas community, and will be embedded with the Norwegian node of the Global Biodiversity Information Facility (GBIF).

To achieve the goals, **Living Norway Ecological Data Network** will:

- Implement state-of-the-art international interoperable technical solutions for archiving, publishing, standardizing and synthesis of data from ecology and associated fields at all organismal levels
- Actively promote data mobilization and data provision through targeted network activity and stakeholder involvement
- Develop new curriculum for academic courses and end-user training, incorporating knowledge about infrastructure usage and related research ethics



Living Norway aim at covering ecological data from surveys, basic research as well as legacy data sources. Data will be harmonized and made available in an interoperable format using internationally recognized data standards. Services will build on and expand current infrastructures provided by GBIF and artsdatabanken with several types of data currently not fully covered (e.g. quantitative ecological data, inventory data with absence information, telemetry data, eDNA).
